Adult Education offers many opportunities for adults to enhance their knowledge in academic, vocational, and vocational areas. Adults' Basic Education classes are for individuals who do not have a high school diploma or GED. Individuals can improve their reading, math, and writing skills. Day or evening classes meet twice a week at locations throughout the county. The cost is \$25 per session plus the cost of books.

If you are a resident of Henrico County and at least 60 years of age, you may participate in our Golden Age Program. Participation is as simple as visiting the nearest school. Golden Age Program flyers are available in the front office of Henrico schools.
