Programs are specifically designed for senior adults who wish to maintain healthy and fulfilling lives. As diverse as the people they serve, these offerings provide a broad range of opportunities and experiences: social events, recreation classes, intergenerational opportunities; day trips, tours; shopping; health fairs, fitness programs, senior Olympics; enrichment classes, language classes, workshops and computer education.

The staff collaborates with other County and community organizations to provide many services for the County's aging population including transportation to and from centers, nutritious lunch, and information and referral to various human services. A sliding fee scale for hot lunches for those 60 or older, a set lunch fee for ages 55-59 and there may be fees for other activities.

The Senior+ Program is an innovative inclusion program, within the senior centers, for seniors with minor cognitive and physical disabilities. Senior+ bridges the gap between day programs for fully independent seniors and those who require more assistance.
