Families in need must apply for assistance by mid-October. Loudoun County residents must meet income requirements and are pre-certified by one of the collaborating agencies. There are many volunteer opportunities available during December and November annually, to include assistance in setting up the Christmas store where clients are given appointments to "shop" for gifts for their families, and serving as "shoppers" to assist and monitor clients as they make their selections.
