- Limited dental services (extractions only)
- Generic medications and insulin through Orange Pharmacy or Wilderness Pharmacy with a \$2.00 charge for each prescription filled.
- Brand name medications can be ordered through the Medication Assistance Program, which has a separate enrollment on-site. Medications can be shipped to the patient's home or to the Free Clinic
