The G. Wayne Fraline Free Clinic For the Homeless provides medical services for homeless men, women, and children. The Clinic operates with a staff nurse, a part-

time nurse practitioner, a medication coordinator, and a host of volunteer healthcare professionals from the community.

Medication Assistance is provided to homeless, jobless, uninsured individuals through the Rescue Mission Free Clinic for the Homeless. Medication and medication management are provided at no charge to homeless patients.

Intense Medical Case Management is the most efficient way to meet these growing needs. Appointments can be made Monday through Friday. Walk-in appointments are available on Tuesday evenings.

Respite Care is available for guests with illnesses and injuries requiring frequent medical treatments, bed rest, or acute management and is managed through the Rescue Mission Free Clinic for the Homeless. Respite Care is intended to last no more than 2 weeks and must be requested directly from a medical provider.

The Clinic is located across the street from the main Mission and is on a city bus route.
