### Senior Housing in Hampton, Virginia

As you explore senior housing options you may find it helpful to check out the <u>Genworth Cost of Care Survey</u>. This tool provides local information on in home care and long term care housing costs. SeniorNavigator can help you find all the local options for senior housing, whatever your needs and budget may be.

- <u>Senior Housing in Hampton</u>: You'll find many choices for 55+ independent living, including some that provide housekeeping, meals and other amenities.
- <u>Assisted Living in Hampton</u>: Local options range from small houses like Bethel Helping Hands Assisted Living, which has just six residents — to large, active communities.
- <u>Continuing Care in Hampton</u>: Also called Life Plan Communities, they help residents secure their futures by providing increasing levels of care.
- <u>Memory Care in Hampton</u>: Find compassionate care that helps people with memory challenges remain healthy and independent for as long as possible.
- Nursing Homes in Hampton: Skilled nursing facilities assist their residents with rehabilitation, complex medical care and other needs.

## Senior Care in Hampton, Virginia

SeniorNavigator lists resources that can help older Hampton residents live independent, healthy and fulfilling lives.

- Adult Day Care and Senior Day Programs in Hampton: Caregivers searching for affordable respite care should contact the <u>Peninsula Agency on</u> <u>Aging</u>, which subsidizes day services for seniors.
- <u>In-Home Care in Hampton</u>: In-home services can include companionship, housekeeping, and skilled nursing care.
- <u>Caregiver Support in Hampton</u>: Every caregiver needs some emotional and practical support. In Hampton, you'll find "lunch and learn" series, respite care programs and other resources.

Successfully aging in place in Hampton may require fixing up your home to be safe and accessible, finding reliable transportation, and sometimes getting assistance to pay essential bills. SeniorNavigator can help you find all of the above!

- <u>Senior Transportation in Hampton</u>: The Peninsula Agency on Aging offers accessible transportation to help seniors get to non-emergency medical appointments, adult day care centers, and sponsored activities.
- <u>Home Modifications in Hampton</u>: Tidewater-area companies and agencies can help renovate your home to be safer, more efficient and wheelchair-

accessible.

• <u>Financial Assistance for Seniors in Hampton</u>: Having a hard time balancing the costs of food, utilities, rent and prescriptions? Several local programs provide financial help to qualifying seniors.
