### **Oral Health and Overall Health**

- Oral health has been called "a window into your overall health" because it can impact your general health and disease (Mayo Clinic, 2019).
- Chronic health conditions can affect oral health, such as diabetes or a weakened immune system (CDC, 2020).
- Since Medicare does not cover routine dental care most older adults do not have dental insurance (CDC, 2019).

- Many older adults are unable to access basic preventive dental care and treatment to keep their teeth and mouths healthy.
- Due to the high cost of dental care many older adults forgo needed dental treatment (AARP, 2018).
- Caregivers and older adults can find the resources and information they need to connect with appropriate oral health supports and services.
